MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Meeting with AECASSOWARY 15

1. At a meeting with AECASSOWARY 15 on 14 June 1955 the following items of interest were revealed by AECASSOWARY 15:

a) AECASSOWARY 2 received a letter from *PIDHAINY on 13 June which was written and sent from London on or about 9/10 June in which he stated that the Professor [] -SIS) said he had nothing against PIDHAINY and *SKOB coming here (United States or Canada?). AECASSOWARY 2 assumed this was for the purpose of confronting MARICHKA (AECARTHAGE 19) with SKOB to learn whether SKOB is the same SKOB mentioned by MARICHKA.

b) In the letter PIDHAINY also stated that [] received communication from BANDERA in which BANDERA requested [] presence in Germany for a [] discussion with him. Topics to be discussed were not made known. It was assumed by AECASSOWARY 2 that this meeting would take place during the week 12-18 June.

c) PIDHAINY was to have returned to Munich from London on 13 June where he would meet with AECASSOWARY 4.

d) PIDHAINY was told by [] that the anti-BANDERA ZChOUN would be supported financially by the British indefinitely and that the anti-BANDERA ZChOUN should seek additional support from the Americans via the ZP.

NOTE: Para 1a above is contrary to the agreed arrangements for confrontation as set during the recent SMOTH-KUBARK meeting which calls for a confrontation in London.
