By the end of the war he was in charge of the Bratislava SD Department which was combating the Slovak Resistance Movement. He allegedly managed to penetrate the movement and acquired papers which allowed him to escape to Austria. Was secretary of the "academic Freedom Fighters" in Vienna and was secretary of the so-called "Austrian College." Albert reportedly was one of the first collaborators of Josef Adolf URBAN and presumably his chief representative in Vienna. He was private secretary to Engr. Richard WCLF, pro-Soviet secretary general of the Democratic Union and tried to get the Allied Council to recognize the Soviet Union. Also closely associated with HCLEC, a former functionary of the Democratic Union. Both were dismissed from the party, however, because they tried to use the party for minument of the Intelligence serifices. Allegedly sends reports to a member of the French Legation, Oney on FRITTWITZ, and maintains close relations with Br. REICHMANN **** of the Austrian Ministry of the Interior who is extremely pro-French. His motivation in his intelligence activities is largely financial.

P/23847 16 Sep 52 Grossbahn Journalist, born 9 Oct 1922, Munich, Austrian citizen. Speaks Southeast European languages fluently and an expert for Southeast Europe. Is presently a correspondent for different West German dailies. Holds close connection with ROKITTA, Whihelm. Left "Interreport Ost" in Mar 52. had acted as liaison between Armand FELINER and ROKITTA.

EASA 712. 19 Jan 53 Brossbahn

Known to have been in close contact with Willi HOETTL as recently as Oct 5%. Known to submit intelligence to ANGERER of Salzburg state police, who carries him as confidential agent "Th" on his list. These reports contain detailed info on western intelligence groups. Reports lately dealing with Dr. Ofczarek's. In contact with Wath Wilhelm ROKITTA, who in turn works for a German operated group together with Georg UBL.
