Subject: YANOVSKIY, Vladimir; AL'BION, fnu Mr.; KHARIZANOVA, fnu Mrs.

1. The following is an extract from a letter received by SHUBA 100. SHUBA 100 reports that the writer is Nikolai Fedorovich PAVLOV (True name AL'FERCHIK), born about 1910. He resides at 6 Wolferhampton Street, Footscray, Victoria, Australia. He is a member of SHUBA 100 from the town Pinsk which was Polish until 1939. During the war he worked in the anti-Communist police in Minsk and Sinolensk. After the war he lived in Austria, where he took an active part in SHUBA 100 work directed against enemy agents. He is an experienced and capable counter-intelligence worker. About 1943 he went to Munich where he lived in the Schleissheim DP camp. In early 1950 he emigrated to Australia. He occasionally sends SHUBA 100 material about Soviet agents or suspicious persons.

2. Traces at your convenience on PAVLOV and the persons mentioned in the report are requested.

The following is an extract from the letter:

One Vladimir ~~YANOVSKIY~~, who had been arrested by the NKVD in 1944, returned to Sofia, Bulgaria from the Soviet Union. Up to and during the war he owned the restaurant "MOSKVA" in Sofia. He was arrested in 1944 for anti-Communist work which he carried on until the arrival of the Soviet Army (according to rumors in ROVS).

A rather large group of Russian anti-Communists were arrested with him. Before his release he was in Moscow, from which he came to Sofia, like a Lord, in a sleeping-car.

Having returned to Sofia he told some people that he saw their relatives in prison camps in Siberia and that many of them were soon to be freed.

In particular, we have living in Melbourne a woman whose husband he also said he had seen and who is also to be released soon. On the basis of letters to this woman, a suspicion has grown up (I cannot confirm it today) that he was sent for work for the MVD.

He stated that one of the Russians arrested with him in Sofia, one AL'BION, on the petition of his wife to the Soviet government, was released and sent to the place of residence of his wife in Vienna - this you should know, as I consider that you can expect anything under present day conditions

from the MVD. From whence they are preparing to strike - its difficult to know. If possible for you to check, tell me immediately as I have taken this game on myself, more truthfully I decided to render aid to the woman, who sent floods of letters on the part of her husband from Sofia.

In connection with this affair I have noticed that one KHARIZANOVA, who lives even now in Bulgaria, travels from time to time to Beirut, where she has a daughter who is married to a rich Arab doctor. After one of these returns to Bulgaria KHARIZANOVA travelled and gave speeches for the benefit of the "Communist Paradise". Evidently, she has connections with the MVD. This should be watched.
