SUBJECT: APYRUBIS, Ignas

TO:

1. Reference is made to your SY memorandum IRP/530, dated 27 October 1955, subject as above, whose name you desired checked against the files of this office.

2. The files of this office contain the following information concerning one Ignas APTRUBIS, who is not positively identifiable with the subject of your request.

3. A report dated 29 March 1950 from an unevaluated source indicated that one Ignas APIRUBIS, a naturalized German citizen, had been sentenced by court martial to four years imprisonment for forgery while he was a captain in the Lithuanian Army in 1933. APIRUBIS claimed that after serving one year (1936-1937) his case was reviewed and he was reinstated into the Lithuanian Army with his former rank and his rights and privileges restored. The rest of the sentence was suspended. According to APIRUBIS' story, his forgery merely consisted in signing a supplier's name to a requisition form to facilitate action.
