ARGENTINE COURT BACKS EXTRADITION BID WITH 43 HURDER CHARGES BY ROSER ATHOOD

BUENOS AIRES, MARCH 2, REUTER - AN ARGENTINE COURT TODAY RULED THAT A FORMER ARMY COMMANDER DETAINED IN THE UNITED STATES HAS RESPONSIBLE FOR 43 MURDERS AND 24 KIDNAPPINGS AND PASSED ON THE CHARGES TO BACK AN EXTRADITION REQUEST.

THE BUENOS HIRES FEDERAL APPEALS COURT ALSO ORDERED POLICE TO ARREST CASHIERED GEN. GUILLERNO SUAREZ HASON ON HIS RETURN TO RRSENTINA.

SURREZ MASON, NOW IN A SAN FRANCISCO JAIL AMAITING AN EXTRABITION HEARING; ALSO FACES HUNDREDS OF TORTURE CHARGES BATING FROM THE TIME OF ARGENTINA'S FORMER MILITARY GOVERNMENT. THE COURT SAID IT GAVE ITS CHARGES TO THE FOREIGN MINISTRY) HATCH HILL THEN SEND THEN ON TO THE COURT THAT IS SCHEDULED TO BEGIN EXTRADITION PROCEEDINGS AGAINST SUAREZ HASON THIS HEEK. SURREZ MASON SERVED AS COMMANDER OF ARGENTINA'S PONERFUL FIRST HRNY CORPS UNDER THE HARSH MILITARY REGINE WHICH HON ARGENTINA A REPUTATION AS ONE THE WORLD'S WORST HUMAN RIGHTS OFFENDERS.

THE BRAY EXPELLED HIN SHORTLY AFTER THE COUNTRY RETURNED TO CIVILIAN RULE IN 1983 AFTER HE REPEATEDLY IGNORED COURT SUMMONSES TO ANSHER CHARGES OF HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES AND ECONOMIC CORRUPTION.

THE COURT: WHICH CONSIDERED 635 CHARGES AGAINST SUAREZ MASON: RULED THAT EVIDENCE WAS STRONGEST IN THE 43 HURDER AND 24 KIDNAPPING CASES.

MANY OF THE CHARGES WERE BROUGHT BY ALLEGED VICTIMS OF GRUESONE TORTURE PRACTICES DURING THE HILLTARY RULE AND BY RELATIVES OF PEOPLE SAID TO HAVE DIED WHILE UNDER SUAREZ MASON'S CAPTIVITY.

ACTING ON AN ARGENTINE REQUEST: POLICE ARRESTED SUAREZ MASON DUTSIDE SAN FRANCISCO IN JANUARY AND BUENOS HIRES ALHOST IMMEDIATELY REQUESTED HIS EXTRADITION.

STATE PROSECUTOR LUIS HORENO DEAMPO TOLD REPORTERS HE WAS CONFIDENT THE U.S. COURT HOULD GRANT THE EXTRADITION BECAUSE " HE HAVE ABUNDANT PROOF (OF) EXTREMELY SERIOUS CRIMES." NORE THAN 9,000 PEOPLE BECAME MISSING AT THE HANDS OF SECURITY FORCES DURING THE PROGENTINE MILITARY'S "DIRTY WAR" AGAINST BUERRILLA VIOLENCE IN THE LATE 1970s, AN OFFICIAL INQUIRT BOARD REPORTED AFTER THE COUNTRY RETURNED TO DEMOCRATIC RULE IN 1983. RESENTINE COURTS ALREADY HAVE BROUGHT 16 RETIRED HILITARY OFFICERS TO TRIAL FOR ATROCITIES AND SOME 200 OTHERS) HANY OF THEN ON ACTIVE BUTY: ARE NOW AWAITING TRIAL. REUTER 1930
