ARVICHOKE Conference, 21 May 1953

1. On 21 May 1953, Thursday, botheen 2:00 and 4:00 FM, an ANTI-GHOME Conference was held in the SD Conference Room, 2050 I Building. Present at the Conference were and the Redical Staff; the second second staff; the Director's Cifice and OSI; and Conference and the representing TSS.
