

During the early part of 1963, NY T-1, another government agency which conducts security type investigations, advised that Heinrichs W. Bagatais, the former Chairman in 1957 of "Daugavas Vanagi" (Latvian Veterans Organization), New York, New York, was suspected of Russian intelligence service involvement by an official German source.

Employment and Associates

On September 9, 1964, NY T-2, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that the subject is employed on West 58th Street, between 10th and 11th Avenues in New York City, New York. NY T-2 did not know the name of the subject's employer, however, he stated the building in which he works is a factory type structure which has no number on its door and is located on the south side of the street. The first floor of this building shows signs in the windows indicating that some sort of printing business occupies the first floor of this building. The building is ten stories tall and the subject is employed as a night watchman in this building.

On September 17, 1964, NY T-2 advised that he had recently heard that Bagatais had quit his job as a night watchman for a firm on West 58th Street, in New York City, New York, on September 7, 1964, to obtain other employment.

On October 8, 1964, NY T-2 advised that the subject is still unemployed, however, he is expected to obtain new employment in the near future.

Heinrichs W. Bagatais

NY T-3, who has furnished reliable information in the past advised on September 16, 1964, that Bagatais reportedly has a girlfriend living in the same apartment building, but in a different apartment than the subject at 412 Cathedral Parkway, New York, New York. This woman, name unknown, provides the subject with meals and she gives him money to live on. NY T-2 stated that the subject is considered to be a homosexual, however, he keeps company with this woman for convenience and companionship.

NY T-3 further advised that Bagatais has parties in his apartment approximately once a month and invites other men to these parties who are also considered to be homosexuals.
