38. Not at present; methods will be developed through RNPILLOW once subject is recruited.
39. Patriotic motives and friendship with subject of MUNIFG 4976.
40. Karlsruhe, ID/EUCOM, and CIC; no traces. Results of CIC check not received as of 12 September.
41. Loyalty to friends, patriotism.
42. Latvian organisation headed by RNPILLOW based in Norway.

45. Subject is being recruited to return to Latvia or the RFSFR as a penetration agent. His birthplace and home are in the Latgalian or easternmost section of Latvia. As he speaks fluent Russian, he could be sent to the RFSFR.
46. Subject was trained by the Wehrmacht for reconnaissance and parachuting.
47. Not applicable.
48. Subject will be given salary and support similar to that given previous agents of same category. Exact terms have not been arranged.

50. Subject could pass as a Russian.
51. Lower middle class.

53. Considered reliable and secure by RNPILLOW and subject of MUNIFG 4976.
54. Subject is not aware that he is cooperating with any foreign power, and would probably only consider working with a Latvian group consisting of persons he knew to be reliable. However, there is no indication that subject would not be willing to work with a group of that sort supported by any of the democratic western powers.
55. Subject is qualified for his mission by his ability to pass as either a Russian or a Latvian, by his training by the Germans in reconnaissance, and his experience in having been parachuted into East Prussia in 1945, as well as his mechanical training.
