- 45. Subject is being recruited to return to Latvia or the RFSFR as a penetration agent. His birthplace and home are in the Latgalian or easternmost section of Latvia. As he speaks fluent Russian, he could be sent to the RFSFR.

- 48. Subject will be given salary and support similar to that given previous agents of same category. Exact terms have not been arranged.
