1. C-3 QUERIED 7 MAY RE ORIGINS HIS RELATIONSHIP BEISSNER. REPEATED STORY GIVEN PARA 1 C-3 4029 (IN 48099) AND STATED FLATLY THIS FIRST MEETING WITH HIM. C-3 THEN REQUESTED B I IN CASE HE RECONTACTED BY BEISSNER. SPIELAN SAID WOULD SEE WHAT AVAILABLE.

2. RADEMACHER APPROACH FOR POLITICAL ASYLUM BASED PRIMARILY ON HIS BELIEF REFUGEE STATUS WOULD OFFER "BETTER BUSINESS POSSIBILITIES" AND WOULD FREE HIM FROM FEAR OF EXTRADITION IF POLITICAL CLIMATE CHANGES. APPROACHED C-3 BECAUSE HE LAWYER WITH POLITICAL CONTACTS.

3. REALIZE ABOVE SHEDS LITTLE LIGHT ON CASE BUT BEST C-3 COULD MUSTER, HE DID NOT REQUEST KJBARK SUPPORT FOR CAIR TRIP AND MATTER NOT PRESSED VIEW REF.
