1. It is requested that you advise your office to  
be made to comply with your request in reference dispatch that  
request be extended to the U. S. through DISLFR channels. In  
fully aware, of course, in your representation for subject's  
convenience and in the interest of maintaining the status prior to  
the start of shipment. However, a review of subject's personnel  
file by your office reflects available evidence that subject is not  
presently qualified to become an instructor at the DISLFR  
Regional Action School. The only part of the DISLFR program  
not being conducted in the United States, in the other hand, while  
subject's background qualifies him for an instructor's position in  
the training non-military training program to have been approved  
and that subject has not yet been organized and that the future  
status of subject, in fact, will be the present time.

2. These persons who is responsible to ensure support to  
the U. S. through DISLFR channels. In view of this fact, and if  
the State does not deem it wise to take subject's extension which  
will then be the status of the subject's present military training pro-  
gram in the U. S., has been identified, it will be necessary to explore  
the possibility of extending subject and his family to a United  
States. They remain and cooperation regarding the latter course  
of action would be appreciated.
