SUBJECT: Dr. Ernst BRUECKNER

1. For the record, I checked with [] of SO on 15 October to ascertain what communication facilities are available to that office to help us establish secure communications with [] in the west coast. Although [] office was anxious to cooperate in this matter he explained that his office had no regular carrier system of teletype communications with their branch office in the west coast. He suggested that I discuss our problem with [] of OO.

2. I contacted [] today and after explaining the problem to him he agreed to the following:

A. His office will advise their branch in San Francisco that certain information will be telephoned to that office within the next few days which should be passed on to []

B. I told [] that we would get off a letter to [] giving him the address of the San Francisco office where the information sent by teletype will be turned over to him. [] is in charge of that office at the following address:

C. We can also make arrangements with [] to have the San Francisco office advance any amount of money we request ~~in cash~~ and make arrangements here for that amount to be transferred to the amount of OO. I told [] we probably would avail of this method and told him that I expected the amount would be probably \$800 or \$900.

D. [] was most cooperative and he volunteered to assist us in securing hotel reservations, if such was desired. He also mentioned that

the San Francisco office could and would be willing to make available to [] a "clean" car if this were needed. I told [] that I did not think we would need an automobile but that if we needed his help on hotel reservations I would let him know. (At this time I do not know whether [] intends to stay with Subject all the time or whether he will commute from Santa Cruz.)

D. I explained to [] that we desired not to become more involved officially with Dr. BRUECKNER than is necessary. I also told him, and requested that he so advise the San Francisco office, that it was imperative that CIA interest in this matter be disclosed *based*
