MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence

VIA: Deputy Director (Plans)

SUBJECT: Request for Reception of Dr. Ernst BRUECKNER,
Chief of the Security Investigation Office of
the German Federal Criminal Police.

1. This memorandum suggests action on the part of the DCI. Such requested action is contained in paragraphs 3 and 4.

2. On Monday, 11 June 1956, Dr. Ernst BRUECKNER, Chief of the Security Investigation Office of the West German Federal Criminal Police (SG of the BKA) will begin a series of briefings and discussions with representatives of CIA and other U.S. government agencies. The SG is responsible for the physical security of high West German government officials, their guests, the buildings in which the West German officials live and work, and for investigation of cases of treason and high treason.

3. According to present plans, Dr. BRUECKNER will receive a briefing on the organization of CIA from [] at 0945 on Monday morning, 11 June, and meet representatives of DDP for additional briefings at 1345 in the afternoon. If possible, we would appreciate your extending to Dr. BRUECKNER a word of welcome.

4. Dr. BRUECKNER will be talking to CIA representatives on 11, 12, and 15 June and his program can be arranged so that he can visit your office at your convenience on any of these days. Since he will be in the Central and Administration Buildings on Monday, 11 June, this date might be convenient.
