1. An examination of records of the former Office of Strategic Services and personal contact with Mr Allen Dulles, formerly of Strategic Services Unit, who initiated the German surrender in Italy, indicate the existence of proof that Eugenio Doliman, formerly SS Standartenfuehrer and aid to General Wolfe, and Eugene Wenner, formerly SS Sturmbannfuehrer, also connected with General Wolfe, now held captive in Italy, participated in the SUNRISE operation. Major General Lemnitzer who participated in SUNRISE negotiations on examination of records and contact with Dulles is also convinced of Dolimans participation. It would appear that present representations by Italians is attempt to undermine Allied position in Italy and in view of the above facts and particularly the repercussions and results that any unjust treatment of these individuals would have on the future long-range United States intelligence activities in Italy, it would appear that Allied interests would best be served if AFHQ would confirm Doliman and Wenner participated in SUNRISE negotiations and show these individuals appropriate consideration in present circumstances.
