 he represented Kesselring, Rahn and Wolff. It was suggested
 to Dollman that as a test of his authenticity and sincerity
 he arrange for the release of certain Italian patriots, then
 in custody of the Germans. The release, which occurred
 shortly thereafter, included Farri, who later became Premier
 of Italy. On 8 March 1945 Wolff plus Dollman and others ar-
 rived in Lugano for definite talks. Wolff, Dollman and
 party then proceeded to Zurich where further discussions
 with OSS representatives took place.
