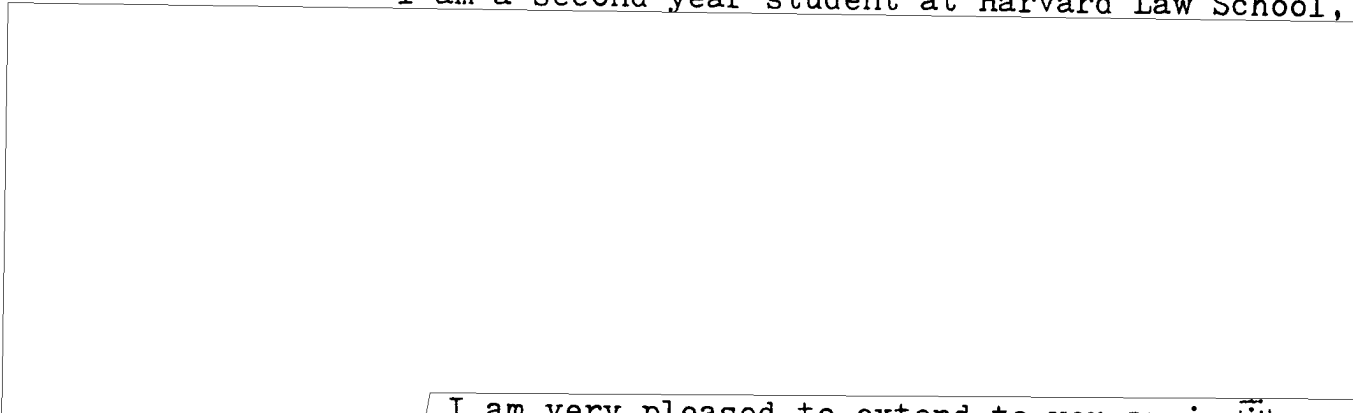

I am a second year student at Harvard Law School,



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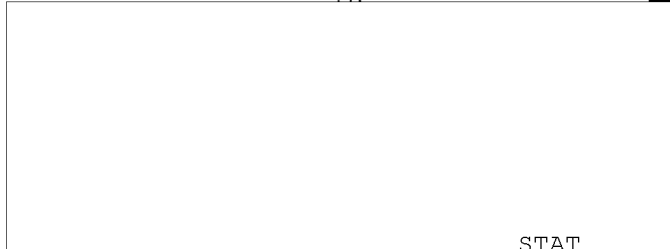

Thanks for your patience and, again, my apologies for having to postpone the trip.

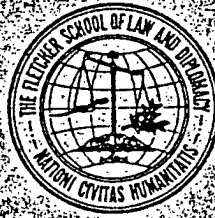


