- 3. The Lao MFA has asked for the cooperation of the USG in preparing its brief concerning its frontiers; in particular, the MFA wishes the American opinion of the portions of the Cambodian note concerning frontiers (sent to the "Regime of Saigon" on January 10, 1965).
- 4. Since the recent International Boundary Study of Laos Viet-Nam Boundary (No. 35, revised June 3, 1966) is unclassified, the Embassy intends to give a copy of it to the Lao Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The Embassy would also appreciate being informed of any other information which the Embassy could provide to the RIG to assist it in its study of the Lao Horder problems.
