Art. 3 - From Mediterranean to frontier of Persia the Turkish frontier is : (1) With Syria: The line described in Art. 8 of Franco-Turkish agreement of Oct. 20, 1921.

(2) With Iraq - to be laid down by arrangement between Turkey and G. B. within 9 months. If no agreement reached by that time the dispute to be referred to League of N. Council.

Territorial provisions of Lausanne Treaty are shorter and simpler than Sevres.

Treaty of Sèvres, August 10, 1920, Armenia, Belgium, Greece, the Hedjaz, Poland, Portugal, Roumania, Serb-Croat-Slovene State, Czecho-Slovakia one part and Turkey.

Art. 94 - Syria and Mesopotamia recognized as independent subject to advice and assistance of a Mandatory power. Comm. to be constituted within 15 days from coming into force of this Tr. to trace frontier described in Art. 27, II (2) and (3).

Art. 27.- Frontier with Syria- Described from outlet of Hassan Dede to N. of Haratash, up the stream Djaihun, Irmak, N. of Urfa, N. of roads connecting Baghche, Aintab, Urfa, then to Ligris, W. of Djezire -ibn-Omar, leaving Mardin to Syria. Ligris down stream, leaving Djezire-ibn-Omar to Syria. With Mesopotamia - Thence to N. bdr of vilaget of Mosul and to meet frontier between Turkey and Persia - N. bdr. of Mosul modified to poss. S. of Amadia.

Art. 95 - Palistine, within bdries to be determined, entrusted to Mandatory which shall effectuate declaration of Nov. 2, 1917 re-national home for the Jews.

TURKEY

Treaty of Sèvres, August 10, 1920.

Art. 101 - Turkey renounces rights and title in or over Egypt as from November 5, 1914.

Art. 113 - Contracting parties recognize Brit.-Egyptian Convention of Jan. 19, 1899 regulating status of Soudan.

Art. 115 - Brit. annexation of Cyprus, Nov. 5, 1914, recognized.

Art. 118 - Turkey recognized Fr. protectorate in Morocco, effective Mar. 30, 1912.

Art. 120 - Turkey recognized Fr. protectorate in Tunis, effective May 12, 1881.

Art. 121 - Turkey renounces rights and privileges left to Sultan in Libya by Treaty of Lausanne, Oct. 18, 1912.

Art. 122 - Turkey renounces to Italy rights and title to islands in Aegean Sea. (Islands named) and also island of Castellorizzo.
