MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD:

CIS Directive [] was published on 17 July. (Not in OCD File)

CIS Directive [] reorganizing CIS, and establishing the Office of Collection [] the Office of Dissemination (Olsen), IGAPS, etc. was published on 19 July (not in OCD file).

Amendment No. 1, dated 22 November, 1946, to CIS Administrative Order [] reorganized CIS, abolishing the separate Office of Collection and the Office of Dissemination. It established the Office of Collection and Dissemination and made certain other changes (Copy in OCD file, "Organization of CIS").

The final report of GPS on Coordination of Collection is in OCD files "Disposition of GPS files" under FCS of 2 October - A, Tab I.

The memorandum from General Wright, directing transfer of GPS files to IGAPS, is in OCD file "Disposition of GPS files", under FCS of 15 October. It was dated 2 October. Under it is filed a receipt (15 October) showing [] receipt of the files into IGAPS. The last page of that receipt shows CIS Directive [] went to IGAPS on 15 October 1946.

The OCD system for coordination collection and dissemination started on 11 October 1946 (see Internal Operating Memo No. 2A, dated 4 November in OCD files).
