1. Submitted herewith is the weekly report for the Intelligence School, Alcott Hall:

- a. This week a schedule of student interviews with the staff was set up to determine job preferences, the value of the course to the students, and to aid the staff in the problem of general, over-all evaluation. (See attached schedule) 25X1
