MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT : Concurrence in Letter Contract No. AL-30-56 with
 the Perkin-Elmer Corporation - Project [redacted]

1. Letter Contract No. [redacted] provides for the production and delivery of three standard width aerial film projectors. Supplier is the Perkin-Elmer Corporation, Norwalk, Connecticut.

2. This requirement originates with D/OP in connection with HT [redacted] and procurement is through Project AQUATONE facilities for reasons of security and for reasons of time required to initiate the necessary procurement through the usual facilities of the Agency since no contractual relationship presently exist between the Agency and this supplier except for Project AQUATONE.

3. Funds in the amount of \$28,740 have been transferred to Project AQUATONE for this procurement [redacted] dated 3 May 1956. Only \$28,543 of such funds are being obligated by this Letter Contract No. AL-30-56.

4. This Letter Contract will be replaced by a definitive contract with the Perkin-Elmer Corporation. Such contract will probably be of a redeterminable fixed price type or, if feasible, a firm fixed price type contract.

5. It is recommended that you approve the signing of Letter Contract No. AL-30-56 by the authorized Project Contracting Officer.
