3. Dr. Tietjen called requesting additional advice with regard to commitment of mental cases. He was apprised that we were reluctant to furnish a "pat" answer to a hypothetical case. Dr. Tietjen indicated that there was an actual case which he would like to discuss within the next few days. (JSwarner)

4. Referred to [] a draft of the proposed regulation pertaining to contacts with private vendors. (JSwarner)



✓ 6. Informed at 5:00 that "L" Building office would be moved to "J" Building Wednesday morning. Checked with [] on the developments and was advised that [] insisted that the move be made at this time. [] assured that necessary partitions and painting would be commenced immediately. (JSwarner)

✓ 7. Attended a meeting in [] office on proposed revision of 9.4 of CFR's, with particular reference to the comments furnished by this office. [] were present. Approximately one-half of the specific comments by this office were covered. One of the major points was not covered. That point pertains to the size of [] level of membership for normal cases.
