Colonel Mareydt provided C/OS with a very detailed description of the recent activities of the USAF Operational Unit of which he had been Commanding Officer and we proceeded to discuss our joint interest in the Washington training end. He expressed the desire to have us continue our two full time instructor participation in the next (January) course, but it was agreed that he would give further thought to pushing the prospective USAF instructors somewhat more rapidly and depend upon us for only one instructor, as had been previously agreed with Colonel Giblo.


