1. <u>Significant Items</u>:

a. Basic Orientation Course #30 ended on Friday, 22 June. Of the fifty-six (56) students enrolled in the Communism phase of the course, 16 received grades of <u>Superior</u>, 16 <u>Excellent</u>, 23 <u>Satisfactory</u> and 1 <u>Failure</u>.

b. As of today, eighty-eight (88) students are enrolled in the Basic Orientation Course #31, which begins Monday, 2 July.

c. Several changes have been made in the course curriculum for Basic Orientation #31. The lectures on the <u>National Security</u> <u>Council</u> and the <u>Production of National Estimates</u> are combined into a new presentation, <u>Policy and National Intelligence Estimates</u>. The lecture on <u>Introduction to Espionage and Counterespionage</u> has been expanded into two lectures, <u>Espionage</u> and <u>Counterintelligence</u>. The lecture on <u>Photo Intelligence</u> has been omitted. A lecture on <u>Clandestine Party Organization</u> has been added.
