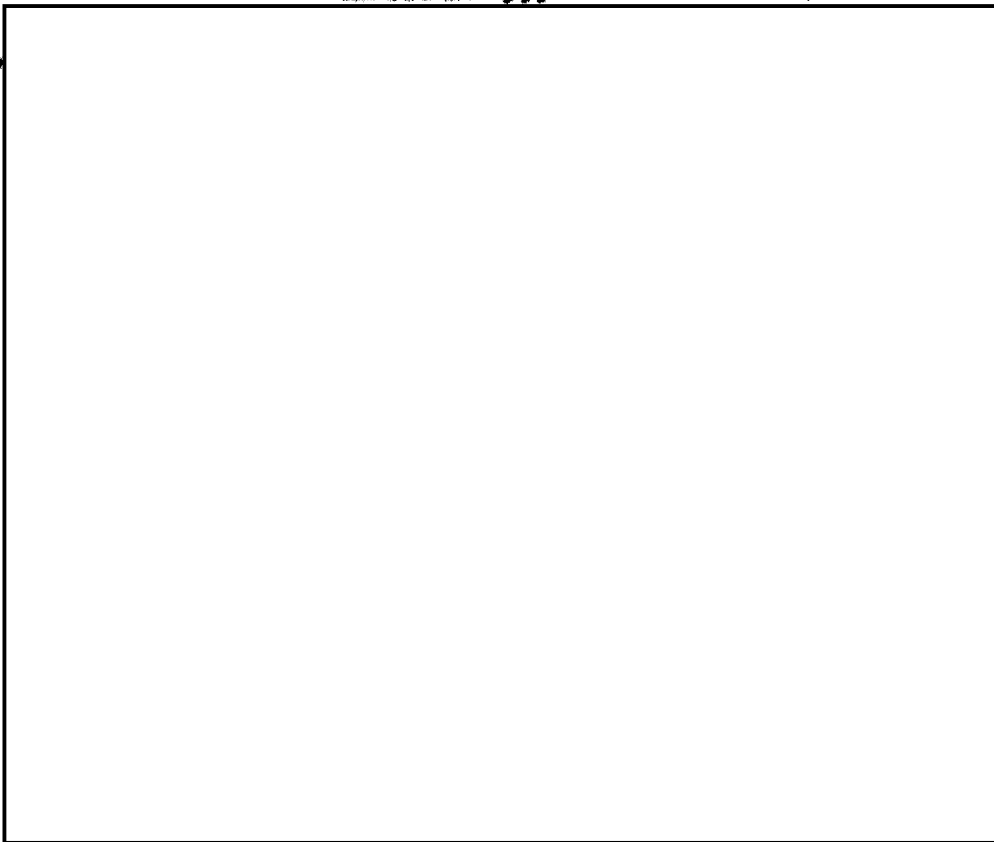

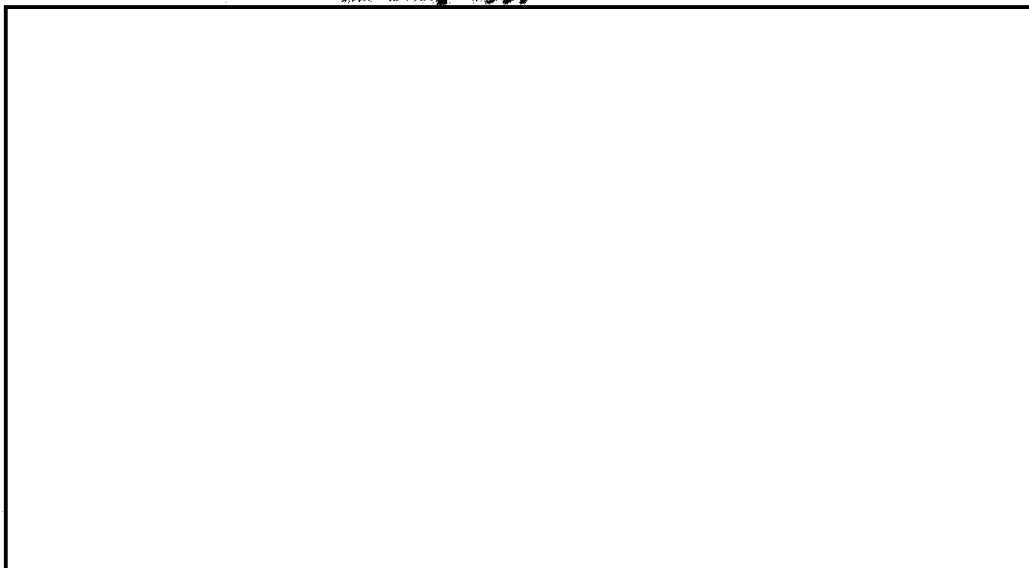

**COMMENT:**

1. The result of private petitions on both sides of the issue shows Langley-McLean area residents favoring CIA's location at Langley in a ratio of about 3.5 to 1.
2. Rep. Broyhill's poll shows residents of the Dranesville District (the area concerned) favoring CIA at Langley by the same ratio. In Fairfax County generally, the ratio is 4 to 1.
3. Congress and other concerned Federal, State and County officials have been privy to CIA's planning throughout.
4. The Fairfax County Board of Supervisors, the senior governing unit of the County, has four times expressed its favorable view.
5. In the official planning bodies, Arlington, Fairfax and Loudoun Counties, the District of Columbia and the City of Falls Church have favored Langley. Only representatives of Maryland and Alexandria have been opposed, and both seek CIA for their areas.
