SUBJECT : Proposed Regulations Relating to PRC Functions

1. At a meeting of the Project Review Committee in August 1954, I took the position that the Project Review Committee, as such, might well be abolished and its functions become the responsibility of the Special Assistant to the Director for Planning and Coordination. There was oral discussion to this suggestion but no formal recommendation was made or acted upon.

2. Imaged as it has been determined that there will continue to be a Project Review Committee, I concur in the substance of the proposed regulations. There are two technical matters on which I will comment. There is a technical discrepancy in proposed

to add to paragraph 4b some such wording as "except those projects
specified in paragraph 5e(3) below." Since proposed Regulations
appear to be procedural in nature, I see no
legal reason why the Director personally must sign them and feel
it would be better, for ease of revision if any, if they were
