1. Colonel White is intensely interested in having a very rapid brief summary from you regarding the legality of the courses of action recommended by the Assistant Director for Personnel in his memorandum dated 18 October 1954, concerning the above subject.

He is also interested in having this summary point up any difference that may now exist between your present thinking on this matter and opinions which you may have given at the time of your earlier contact with this case referred to in paragraph 10 of Mr. Kirkpatrick's memorandum of 1 October 1954, addressed to the Director of Central Intelligence on the same subject.

3. For your information, Colonel White has promised Mr. Kirkpatrick that he would have his action recommendation in the latter's hands by 20 October 1954.
