At a meeting of the Career Council, it was agreed that the substitute proposals of the Bureau of the Budget on the retirement provisions in the new CIA legislation were wholly unacceptable to the Agency. It was thereupon agreed that rather than enter into what might be a long and useless debate with the Bureau, we would withdraw our proposal for special retirement provisions, and take the matter up again at some time in the future after the Administration position becomes clearer on the subject.
