SUBJECT: Requirements on Soviet Geodesy and Cartography

1. I have talked at length on this subject with the Reports Officer
 25X1 and other personnel [] They are greatly interested in the require-
 ments, and indicate that there may be new opportunities for taking action.
 Briefly, the situation (some of which is doubtless known to you) is as
 follows:

25X1A a. [] has no record of receiving the Information Guides on
 geodesy and cartography previously submitted by QRR to DD/P. To date,
 therefore, any guidance on the subject has been limited to that con-
 tained in general reference compendia.

c. Under the Related Missions Directive, the field can undertake
 a wide range of projects with prior specific authorization from
 Washington. In addition, it can request preparation of an Information
 Directive if on review of a requirement it is found that there is a
 field capability.
