MEMORANDUM FOR: NIS Chapter IX Contributors

SUBJECT: Evaluation of Maps Cited in Section 91

1. In an effort to standardize terminology used in Section 91 for the evaluation of maps that range from "poor to fair," "good to fair," etc., it is requested that the procedure followed in evaluating the hydrographic charts be followed for all contributions.
2. The first evaluation given should be the dominant one. An evaluation of "poor to fair," for example, means preponderantly poor, whereas "fair to poor" means preponderantly fair.
3. If neither part of the evaluation predominates, the evaluation statement should be expanded for clarity.
