2. Draft copies of the proposed regulation on EOD training for new professional personnel have been given to the Executive Secretary of the CIA Career Service Board. At its meeting on 15 January, the Board will consider the various proposals set forth. Coordination of the regulation with the DD/I, DD/A and DD/P is in process.

3. As a result of negotiations with USAF personnel <sup>AND</sup> of the Director of Training's office during the week, the Office of Training has been offered five positions in an intensive course in Azerbaijani given under the auspices of the Air Force at the University of Indiana from 16 February to 15 August 1953. Chiefs of the SR and NSA divisions in FI are presently surveying their needs with the intention of availing themselves of this opportunity to obtain training in one of the rare languages.

4. The Department of State continues to send selected personnel to the weekly Indoctrination Course.

5. The Human Resources Program in FDD was begun on Tuesday with a group of 15 Branch Chiefs.

6. Members of the Support Staff, OTR, participated in the briefing of students for the Operations Course [REDACTED] held on 7 January. The briefing was also attended by training officers of divisions sending students to Operation Courses. After the formal briefing, the training officers were further briefed concerning some of the unique problems arising from the move of the Operations Course from Washington.

7. Sufficient material has been gathered to set up field exercises for the Evasion and Escape Course [REDACTED] and a survey of facilities at that area will be made at the conclusion of the current Course.

On 5 January, OTR announced a new, 3-week Air Operations Staff Course consisting of theoretical and practical presentations of [REDACTED] subjects, to begin on 26 January and end on 13 February 1953. The course will be presented [REDACTED] to students whose assignment or projected assignment will be associated with the planning, implementation or support of [REDACTED] operations. The course will purposely be limited to not less than six or more than twelve students. This limitation is necessary in order to give each student

10. Verbal information has reached OTR that the Office of DD/P has no interest in facility [REDACTED]. A representative of OTR will act as consultant to the Office of DD/A in the liquidation of the facility.

11. Preparations have been completed for Operational Security Course No. 3 designed for senior staff officers, and will be given beginning 12 January 1953.

12. As of 10 January 1953, 158 CIA personnel are enrolled in TR(S) training courses, 213 in TR(G) courses, and 203 in external training, making a total of 574 in training programs under the jurisdiction of OTR as a whole.
