1. The following is quoted from DTR's dispatch concerning his [redacted] for your information and action:

"5. PERSONNEL TRAINING PROBLEMS: [redacted] currently enrolled in [redacted] advises that CIA should think twice before enrolling additional personnel in this program. The ultimate objective of the school is the granting of the master's or doctor's degree and leave entirely up to the student the manner of achieving the necessary learning. As a result, there is little classroom work, tests or other evaluative procedures. In addition, to achieve a degree, minimum residency is required which oftentimes CIA personnel cannot meet. Subject now faces this problem of returning to the U.S. and wanting to continue her studies has nothing upon which a transfer of credits can be accurately accomplished. LETS should be advised to look into this matter."
