1. It is my opinion that confusion results and no benefits are gained from the different job titles for senior executives in the Agency. Specifically, while we have an Assistant Director for Communications, there is a Director of Training (under DCI), and a Director of Security (under DD/A). Similarly, there is confusion in having both an Assistant Director (Personnel) and a Personnel Director.

## 2. I recommend that:

- a. the title of the Director of Training be changed to Assistant Mirector for Training, with corresponding change for his deputy:
- b. the Assistant Director (Personnel) be changed to Assistant Director for Personnel, for uniformity, and the title of Personnel Director be changed to Deputy Assistant Director for Personnel;
- c. the Director of Security be changed to Chief of Security to correspond to other office heads under DD/A, who: are all designated as Chiefs.
- 3. As far as the DD/I offices are concerned, all office heads are Assistant Directors, which appears to be correct. It is not believed practical to make any changes in DD/P titles at this time.
