You will recall from my letter of January 30th that we have been organizing a Conference in Copenhagen with the Russians, having to do with joint Arctic research. Just now I have received word that the Russians have accepted the invitation to the Conference and will meet with us on May 19th through 21st. As you know, I am anxious to get some sort of opinion from the Department on what we can say on a reciprocal exchange of persons between Siberia and Alaska.
