- 1. Reference is made to our memorandum dated 10 March 1959, wherein you were advised that captioned Subject had addressed a letter to the President in which she protested U. S. planes traversing Russian territory. As you will recall, Subject's letter was enswered by the Air Force; and an investigation was initiated by the Office of Security which revealed that Subject had an extensive record of Communist Party membership and associates.
- 2. This is to advise that further inquiries by the Office of Security substantiated Subject's subversive activities and, in addition, revealed that she has been active in massrous organizations cited by the Attorney General pursuant to E. O. 10450.
- 3. Although Subject has an active history of Communist Party activities, it is the opinion of the DFD Security staff that the Subject's letter to the President was merely for propaganda purposes and the action of a "crank" rather than a person actively engaged in espionage activities. Therefore, we are taking no further action.
- 4. It is requested that this memorandum be returned to this office for retention after it has served your purpose.
