1. The subject report [redacted] May 1957 to the Baltic Shipyard in Leningrad. The report states that the source has indicated willingness to answer any questions which may arise from this report. It is requested that the following requirements be served on the source of the subject report. Numbered shipyard installations refer to the same reference used in the subject report - ONI Port Study Series [redacted] dated March 1957, Leningrad USSR. 25X1A2g

2. What is under construction in building #291?

3. It is possible that the diesel tug boats referred to in paragraph 2b, of the subject report, are the icebreaker tugs reported by the Soviet Press to be under construction in the yard. According to a Soviet Press article, Vodnyy Transport of November 17, 1956, the first hull was laid down November 6, 1956. Where are these hulls under construction in the shipyard?

4. What preparations were under way for construction of the 25,000 ton (cargo carrying capacity) tanker?

5. Could source give any information on the design bureau and yard engineering offices located in the shipyard?

6. Does source have any knowledge of construction in the yard other than for the yard's own ships, such as hull sections and machinery for other shipyards and components for industrial or agricultural use?

7. Did source observe any construction of submarines or components parts for such?
