1. I am attaching hereto the PHS for [REDACTED] together with the Request for Personnel Action.

2. I have known [REDACTED] usually in connection with the work of the EIC Subcommittee on Industrial Machinery and Equipment to which he was [REDACTED] representative. In these meetings he conducted himself very creditably. I have also reviewed his PHS carefully and I have interviewed him at length following the submission of the PHS. Moreover, I have read selected sections of his Master's thesis, now in preparation, as well as one report he prepared.

3. [REDACTED] is not the strongest applicant I have ever interviewed but I do think that he is average or somewhat better and that he would bring to the job in D/I certain real assets. First, he knows a little bit about intelligence and quite a bit about the sort of work D/I does. He enjoys this sort of work and hopes to make a career of it taking additional education which may be required. Secondly, he knows sources and should be fairly productive in a short period of time. This is particularly true in the industrial machinery categories to which he was assigned in [REDACTED]. Third, he has a good attitude toward the work and would be "retreadable" as our needs change. 25X1A

4. It is difficult to judge what the potential of a new applicant may be but I would guess that [REDACTED] may have a ceiling at about Grade GS-13. He writes well and might develop beyond this level. 25X1A9a
