MEMORANDUM FOR MR. EDDY

Subject: Interrogation of Returning Attaches

1. I am fully in accord with the suggestion you have made in your letter of April 17, 1947, concerning interrogation of returning chiefs of missions, under the auspices of the Central Intelligence Group.

2. It is my sincere hope that these arrangements may be extended to include those Ministers Counselor and high ranking consular officers from semi-independent areas, where they are considered to have foreign intelligence information of mutual value to the intelligence agencies or to CIG.

3. I am also writing General Chamberlin, Admiral Inglis and General McDonald suggesting that returning Military, Naval and Air Attaches be included in a parallel arrangement.
