MEMORANDUM FOR: THE DIRECTOR

SUBJECT: Report on Soviet Jamming of the Voice of America

1. COAPS thinks the attached Report from the Ad Hoc Committee on Soviet Jamming of the Voice of America should go to all members of the Intelligence Advisory Committee for approval rather than to the National Security Council and that only an information copy should, at this time, go to the National Security Council. Accordingly we have rewritten the proposed memorandum from OSI to the Executive Secretary of the National Security Council into a memorandum for all members of the Intelligence Advisory Committee.

2. When the members of the Intelligence Advisory Committee have approved of the Report, then we can decide what to do with regard to the National Security Council. Maybe by that time some action will have been taken on NSC 66. Apparently, however, those handling priorities in the Communications field will oppose any readjustment (Recommendation No. 2 on page 4) and that probably is where State will not take NO for an answer.
