Joint Manuals Establishing Policies and Procedures for the Exploitation of Captured Intelligence Sources

- 1. Reference memoranda conveyed to the Chairman, Intelligence Advisory Committee, the joint manuals which establish policies and procedures for the exploitation of captured intelligence sources. These manuals had been approved by the Joint Intelligence Committee and concurrence of the IAC was requested.
- 2. The manuals have been concurred in by appropriate offices within CIA, as noted below, and by the Department of State, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the Atomic Energy Commission.
- 3. The draft agreement (attached as TAB B) by which CIA would undertake to represent the interests of the Department of State and the Atomic Energy Commission with respect to these matters is acceptable to these agencies and should be concluded before the activation of the Joint Materiel Intelligence Agency (expected during the summer). It should be particularly noted, however, that this Agreement would commit CIA to representation in Theaters of Operations, not yet confirmed in writing.

4. It is recommended:

- a. That the notification attached as TAB A be forwarded to the Joint Intelligence Committee.
- b. That this office be authorized to proceed with the conclusion of the Agreement attached as TAB B, subject to the Director's being satisfied that CIA can assume the obligations contained therein.
