**SUBJECT: Intelligence Projects Related
to Psychological Warfare**

1. Attached for your information are the reports of State, Navy and Army (G-2) of their intelligence production related to psychological warfare for the month of September. The Air Force reported that they are beginning work on a series of studies on "Significant Soviet and Satellite Air Force Personalities."

2. The results of the questionnaire distributed last month indicate a desire on the part of a majority of the recipients to continue to receive these reports. Almost all of them indicated, however, that their purposes would be served adequately if they received the reports of each producing organization directly. It is accordingly requested in the interests of efficiency that from now on each agency distribute its own report and that the distribution include those listed below.

3. The suggestion has been received from Captain Anoll, USN, that the listings would be more helpful if they were divided into (a) those primarily designed for psychological warfare purposes and (b) those indirectly of interest to psychological warfare. This suggestion is passed on for your consideration.
