2. [redacted] informed those at the meeting that, effective 1 January 1953, a Building Supply Officer would be assigned responsibility for subject buildings. He will be located in 1152 G Building and will be responsible for expendable and non-expendable property and for purchase and service requirements.

3. One problem involves accomplishing a physical inventory of the non-expendable property in the subject buildings. It was agreed that on Saturday, 13 December, and Sunday, 14 December such an inventory would take place; this was subsequently postponed until sometime after 1 January 1953.

4. It was recognized that, in addition to the inventory, considerable problems remained to be solved. The undersigned reminded those present of

It was suggested that [redacted] services will be available to those concerned with implementing the functions of the new Building Supply Officer. It was the sense of the meeting that the creation of such an officer would be of great ultimate benefit to the Offices concerned and that the Offices might well establish a single point of control for the relations of each Office with the Building Supply Officer. 25X1A9A
