1. This Office addressed the DDCI by memorandum (reference a) on 27 January 1954 requesting advice for the undersigned to negotiate the proposed DCID 11/2 with the IAC agencies prior to formal submission to the DCI for approval and the IAC for concurrence. The memorandum had the following concurrences:

- a. The ADD/A had concurred.
- b. FI had concurred and would recommend concurrence to DD/P.
- c. AD/O, AD/CI, AD/RR, AD/SI, AD/NE and AD/IC had concurred.
- d. AD/CD nonconcurred and his comments were attached.

2. The DD/I authorized the AD/IC to explore the matter with other IAC agencies, reserving his opinion as to the position he would advise the DCI to take after the other IAC agencies had been consulted.

3. This Office took the matter up with the IAC agencies (reference b) and two revisions were made (references c and d).

4. The agreement obtained to the draft DCID 11/2 among the IAC representatives represents a staff agreement and not the official position of any agency.

5. I would appreciate your concurrence or nonconcurrence with the draft DCID 11/2 as revised by the IAC representatives (use the 6 April 1954 draft, reference d). Please have your representative contact  of my staff by 21 April 1954.
