MEMORANDUM FOR: Special Assistant to the Director
for Planning and Coordination

SUBJECT: International Communism

1. In response to your request of last week I have prepared the attached memorandum which you might wish to send to the Director (also attached for your convenience are copies of the relevant papers).

2. Your original paper to the Director is now in the hands of the DDS and I have offered my services to White's office to provide any background briefing which might make their task easier; so far I have received no invitation.

3. I would at this time remind you of two things: (a) that you may be expecting a call from Macy of the Bureau to talk over this whole matter, his enthusiasm arising from the fact that the Bureau read your paper which went to the State Department; and (b) that at our last conference with Mr. Armstrong and Mr. Howe you indicated that at some point (and I do not recall precisely when that was to be) you would make available to the State Department a copy of your memorandum to the Director in order that Park might register with the Director such comment as he saw fit. I would recommend that the time has come when, if it is to be useful in this problem, a copy be made available to Park on the basis you indicated. On your authorization I will be glad to accomplish this.
