1. I am attaching hereto a tabulation of the numbers of the various types of racks required by using agencies for read-out equipment for Systems One, Three, Four and Five.

2. You will note that Tab A is a tabulation of equipments for which the Agency accepts financial responsibility. Those equipments required for the Detechments A. B and C (AQUATONE), are essential to check on and continue effective use of the collecting equipment. The three racks for NSA are on loan. There exists a memorandum of understanding with NSA which states that if they require additional equipments for their use in carrying out their own function they would file a procurement request accordingly.

3. It is understood that the Office of Scientific Intelligence maintains the read-out equipments in Barton Hall both for analysis purposes in the normal function of intelligence production and to provide research and development support to the collection projects in question.
