SUGGESTED PROCEDURE FOR HANDLING DELETIONS TO TARGET LISTINGS

At the time the plots for a given mission are completed, the OCR Element of HTA will take the following steps:

- 1 Record the coordinates of the coverage made good, excluding all cloud covered areas or partially covered areas, etc.
- 2 Punch these coordinates into machine tabulating cards (IBM).
- 3 Match these IBM cards with the master deck of IBM cards containing low-priority targets (identified in the existing Target Listings as Z-1, Z-2 and Z-3 priority targets)
- 4 Matching cards will be listed and copies of this listing will be disseminated to all ARC members for deletion consideration.
- 5 At a subsequent ARC meeting these deletions will be discussed. Any targets which are felt must remain in the Target Listings must be justified before the ARC.
- 6 A special listing of these deletions will be prepared for the Director of Operations, Project Headquarters to aid in mission planning.
