MEMORANDUM TO CHAIRMAN ARC

28 February 1957

SUBJECT: Justification for Penetration

DOE & ARMY review(s) completed.

- 1. Reference is made to draft paper, same subject, dated 20 Feb 57.
- 2. ACSI is in general agreement with the paper and suggests modifications set forth in paras 3 and 4 below.
- 3. Under individual target listings change headings of "What we will see" and "What we will learn" to "What we should see and what we should learn".
- 4. The following additional specific amendments are proposed:
 - a. Page 1, para 1, line 2 -- insert continental before US.
 - b. Page 5 -- add May be able to identify function of Mozhaysk by comparison.
 - c. Page 6, para 3, What we should learn -- change to Whether Mozhaysk is related to GM or atomic energy or both.
