I should prefer that our FI position on where we are going be established before others are cut in. I did discuss it informally with [redacted] who suggested that specialized training on the FI programs be limited to that which the FI Staff can accomplish internally.</p> <p>TAB C which outlines possible coverage for a specialized course is purposely broad and is organized into five PARTS which can be juggled to meet the needs of various officers, e.g. PARTS I, II, III would meet the needs of the Headquarters executive who is excluded from the CSR, while PARTS III, IV and V would be available to the returning senior case officer who completed CSR. Likewise, any PART could be separately developed as a specialized course.</p> <p>1. 4 - This is a very fine study in my opinion, and is in line with the purposes of such a study.
