RECORD OF STATEMENT OF UNITED STATES DELEGATION

concerning

INFORMING NON-PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES OF INTERNATIONAL LIST REVISIONS

17th March, 1960

Present: Belgium(Luxembourg), Denmark, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Turkey,
United Kingdom, United States.

On March 17, the United States Delegate reported that under its responsibility to inform certain non-participating countries of revisions in the International Lists, the United States Government had, through its Embassies, given copies of the recently revised International Lists (Document 4000) to the governments of Austria, Sweden, and Switzerland. This had been done at the earliest possible dates after the issuance of the revised lists. With respect to Austria, the United States Delegation had subsequently assisted the United States Embassy in Vienna in explaining the list revisions to the Austrian Government. (At the same time, the United States Delegation had discussed Austrian trade controls with the Embassy and with Austrian officials in preparation for the forthcoming meeting of the Subcommittee on Export Controls - see COCOM Document 3921).

The United States Delegate also reported that the February 1 (1960) edition of the Mutual Defense Assistance Control ("Battle Act") Lists, incorporating changes corresponding to those made in the International Lists as of February 1 - see COCOM Document 3913 - was currently being given the customary distribution to non-member governments.
