Export of Infra-red Detector Cells  
To Poland

Memorandum by the United Kingdom Delegation

The United Kingdom authorities have been asked to approve the export to Poland of two Infra-red Detector Cells, type P.C. 21, valued at \$126, which are covered by the definition of I.L. Item 1548.

2. The importer is ELEXTRIM of Warsaw and the cells are stated to be for use in experimental work in the optical laboratories of the Polish Academy of Science. The usual assurances against re-export would be obtained.
3. Her Majesty's Government consider that this requirement is reasonable and wish to authorise the export under the special Polish exceptions procedure. They would be grateful for the views of Member Governments by December 3.
